TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH PROSPECTIVE GIDEONS

Hello, (first name). My name is <u>John Oss</u>. I am a member of the Gideons International ... you know, the Christian business and professional men who place Bibles in hotels.

(First name), we've been contacting pastors and church leaders in the area, and your name came up in a conversation as a dedicated Christian man and I appreciated hearing about that.

It is my understanding that you are the (name of position) of (co. name) . Is this correct?

The reason I'm calling is the Gideons are inviting an outstanding group of Christian laymen, from the local area, to be our guest at a rare dinner event. I will mail you (or email if you prefer) a letter to confirm all the information I mentioned earlier regarding the dinner, the time, the place, etc., and in this confirmation I will include a telephone number. Then if something unforeseen should come up and you can't attend, you would be kind enough to give us a call wouldn't you?

To what address would you like me to send the letter? (Fill in Pocket card)

I will send you the confirmation soon, and will include a link to our website. The website will provide you with some good information about our ministry, as well as some important items that we would ask you to pray about and consider prior to the dinner.
