The goal of ETIMS is to modernize the management/distribution of technical orders from a manual process to an integrated, web-based enterprise system. ETIMS will utilize GOTS, custom code and existing services to enhance the management of Air Force technical order information. Web-based for ease of use, accessed via the Air Force Portal and integrated with the Global Combat Support System - Air Force (GCSS-AF), ETIMS will eliminate the need for multiple Technical Order management systems, will provide accurate and up-to-date information, and will support both digital and paper TO formats. ETIMS will ultimately be subsumed by ECSS.

Financial Information Resource System (FIRST) -

Leveraging COTS and GCSS-AF enterprise services, FIRST is a vehicle for transforming existing financial applications into a modern, integrated, flexible, and Financial Systems Integration Office/Chief Financial Officer (FSIO/CFO) compliant information and budget decision support system. Authorized users at any organizational level shall be provided access through a modern, secure, web-enabled, and robust technological infrastructure. The fundamental objectives of FIRST Budget Formulation (BF) shall be to reduce the overall resources required to operate and manage the Air Force budget process, to increase the flexibility of the budget processes, to meet the improved accounting, reporting, and auditing practices provisions of the CFO Act requirements, and to integrate into the GCSS-AF environment. These objectives comprise the underlying foundation for the more specific project objectives contained herein.

Defense Enterprise Accounting Management System (DEAMS) -

The U.S. Transportation Command (USTRANSCOM), the U.S. Air Force (USAF), and the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) have joined forces to develop and implement a single financial system - the Defense Enterprise Accounting and Management System (DEAMS).

DEAMS was established by the Office of the Secretary of Defense's (OSD) Business Management Modernization Program (BMMMP) Financial Management Transformation Team to transform business and financial management processes and systems. It is a cross-services initiative to replace accounting and financial management legacy systems with a Commercial-Off-The-Shelf (COTS) based solution that is qualified by the Joint Financial Management Improvement Program.

DEAMS will implement reengineered business processes based on the COTS solution and commercial best practices. Executed within the Global Combat Support Services - Air Force Integration Framework, DEAMS will provide an enterprise-level view of financial data supporting decision-making at all levels.

Built on an Oracle database and enterprise resource planning system, MIPDS is one of the world's largest human resources systems, encompassing over 200,000 business rules related to the continued support of Air Force members. Data from MIPDS feeds into systems for pay, promotions, assignments, and training. Much of MIPDS will eventually be subsumed by DIMHRS, the Defense Integrated Military Human Resources System, but until such time it will remain the premiere "weapon system" for the Air Force's most vital component - its people.
