

Menu and Toolbars



Menu

Clicking on each item in the menu bar produces a list of actions that you can perfom on the map. Some actions in the menu are also shown in the tool bars, and their associated icon can be



seen to the left of the action. The keyboard shortcut is displayed to the right of the action.



Right click locations, pushpins, and other map objects to call up a 'Shortcut Menu' for common commands that you can perform on the item clicked.

Standard Toolbar



Creates a new map



Opens an existing map



Saves the map



Prints current map view. See File/Print in menu for more options



Choose pushpin type and add to the map



Display the legend and overview pane



Find nearby places



Display the route planner



Display the GPS task Pane



Display search results



Display the driving directions pane



Display the navigation pane



Switch to full screen navigation view. Only available when running a route



Send the map to a mobile phone



Show the current map view in Bing™ Maps



Get help

Advanced Toolbar



To find an address or location, type a place name into the search bar and click the magnify button. An exact match will display at the center of the map. If no exact match, a dialogue box opens with possible matches.



Click the 'minus' and 'plus' buttons to zoom out/in. Drag the zoom slider to zoom as well.



Change the map type including: Road Map, Terrain Map, Political Map, Road Map (night).

Drawing Toolbar



Draw Button: Set object display order, Toggle size on/off



Highlight



Scribble



Line



Arrow



Freeform



Rectangle



Oval



Radius (Toggle size using Draw Button)



Text Box



Select the shape fill color



Select the line color



Select the text color



Select the line width



Select an arrow style

Location and Scale Toolbar

North America United States

Place names will display depending on zoom level.

Click a name to automatically zoom to that level on

New Hampshire

Manchester



If place name has triangle next to it, clicking will show additional zoom options.

Useful Keyboard Shortcuts

Map Shortcuts

the map.

Right click, drag box and click in box

Zooms map to within defined area

Double left click

Zooms the map in

ARROW keys

Move the map in the direction of the arrow key that is pressed if focus is on the map.

ALT+LEFT ARROW

Brings user back to previous map views

ALT+RIGHT ARROW

After returning to the previous map view, show the original map view

again.

CTRL+E

Activate the measure distance tool.

CTRL+SHIFT+C

Copy the map to the Clipboard.

CTRL+ALT+C

Copy latitude and longitude of pointer's current position on map.

MINUS SIGN (-) Zoom the map view out.

Ctrl + Z undo last action

PLUS SIGN (+) Zoom the map view in.

Routing Shortcuts

Recalculate a route from the current position to the place or address typed in the text box in the Routing section of the

GPS task pane.

CTRL+SHIFT+R

Reverse the currently displayed route.

NavigationShortcuts

SPACEBAR

Repeat an instruction. Press twice to hear the next

instruction.

Open or close the full screen map view.

ESC Close the full screen map view.

Turn voice instructions on or off.

Turn the night display on or off while full screen navigation is open.
