

Single-Stream Recycling is Here!

Norristown has a new recycling program which makes it easier then ever to recycle.

WHAT IS SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING?

Single stream recycling allows residents to place all recyclables: cans, bottles and plastics together with newspapers, cardboard, etc. in one container. There is no need to separate since the "single stream" recycling process used allows all recyclables to be mixed together.

ADDITIONAL RECYCLING CONTAINERS

If you want to use an extra container for recycling collection, simply go to the Norristown Municipal building and get a RECYCLING STICKER. You can use any container up to 40 gallons as well as your existing recycling bin. Make sure that the sticker is visible.

Recycling Bins are available at Norristown Municipal Building, located at 235 E. Airy Street (610) 272-8080.



Single stream recycling will be collected by a compaction truck. Only recyclables will be on this truck on your recycling day, it cannot collect non-recyclable items.

THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS CAN ALL BE PLACED IN THE SAME RECYCLING BIN:

METAL:

Aluminum cans (beer and soda) aluminum foil and foil plates, etc. Metal lids, Metal food cans (tin/steel).

GLASS:

Glass bottles and jars (food and drink only).

PLASTIC CONTAINERS:

Bottles and containers labeled #1 through #7 (soda, water, milk, juice, liquor, shampoo, detergent, condiments, salad dressing, yogurt, margarine).

MIX PAPER AND CARDBOARD:

Can be placed loose in the recycle bin or extra container. Material such as newspaper, inserts, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, envelopes, file folders, office white, colored and computer paper (staples and paper clips ok). Corrugated cardboard boxes, cereal, tissue, gift boxes, etc. (remove liners) paper bags, phone books, wrapping paper (remove metallic paper, bows, etc.).



DO NOT RECYCLE!

Ceramics, dishes, coffee cups, drinking glasses glass oven ware, pyrex, vision Ware, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs plastics without #1 through #7 labeling, plastic bags, styrofoam packaging, bubble wrap tissue or paper towels, milk or juice wax paper cartons, metallic or coated paper, waxed boxes, books or toys.

Rules about Collection

Trash and Recycling: Trash MUST be placed in a container, no larger than 32 gallons, with a tight fitting lid. DO NOT put trash out in loose bags! Place trash and recycling out the night before pick up. Trash and recycling are collected once a week; there is a four container limit. No more than 50 lbs per trash container.

Bulk Waste: Includes furniture, mattresses, large carpets, etc. Picked up on regular collection day; limit <u>one bulk item</u> per week.



Major Appliances: will be collected by appointment only, call us at 1-800-432-1616. Appliances like refrigerators must have any doors removed prior to putting them out for collection.

Yard Waste: Yard waste and grass clippings;



branches or sticks one inch thick need to be tied and bundled and not exceed 3 foot in length, collected curbside once a month; one day after your scheduled trash and recycling day. Collection will begin the 2nd
Monday of every month, place in container or biodegradable paper bags.

Holidays

If your collection day falls on a holiday it will be collected the next day. Trash and recycling collection will resume on the following day. **Holidays:**New Year's Day (January 1), Memorial Day, Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day (December 25).

No Home Construction or Demolition Debris!

If you're putting on a new roof or remodeling your house, you need to make special arrangements with us or another waste hauler to remove the debris.

No Hazardous Wastes!



Car batteries, gasoline, motor oil, pesticides, oil-base paints and other toxic and hazardous materials do not belong in the trash! Call the The Waste System Authority of Eastern Montgomery County at 610-278-3045. For information on disposing of these materials. Many auto stores accept used motor oil and car batteries.

Basura y Reciclaje Pick Up en Norristown Ayúdenos a mantener Norristown limpio!

- La basura debe ser colocada en un recipiente, no más de 32 galones, con una tapa que cierre bien. NO coloque la basura en bolsas sueltas. Las bolsas sueltas deben colocarse adentro del recipiente de la basura! Ponga todo la basura afuera de la casa la noche anterior.
- Recicle! Coloque las latas, tarros y botellas de vidrio (alimentos y bebidas sólo incluyendo botellas de cerveza), alimentos de plástico y envases de bebidas, papel y cartón en un recipiente de reciclaje de basura por separado - no en el recipiente de basura regular. Contenedores de reciclaje están disponibles en el Edificio Municipal o usted puede utilizar cualquier recipiente con una etiqueta de reciclar. Etiquetas de reciclaje están también disponibles en el Edificio Municipal.
- Sólo se puede colocar un mueble en la calle para ser recogido cada semana.
